1. Applicant must be a member, in good standing, with Cinfed Credit Union. Not a member? [Click here to join!](#)
2. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 Grade Point Average. Pending winners will be notified via email and phone call immediately and will have 5 days (120 hours) from the time the email is sent to provide the following documentation (as well as a self-portrait):
 - An original or copy of the most recent high school or college transcript or report card that clearly displays cumulative GPA
 - Results of the ACT, PSAT and/or SAT for students entering college for the first time
 - A letter of acceptance from an accredited college or university for students entering college for the first time
3. All forms and information submitted are confidential, non-returnable and must be postmarked or submitted online by May 1st.
4. Incomplete applications will not be considered - be sure all requested information is supplied
5. Confirmed scholarship recipients will be notified by mail as well as announced at the Cinfed Annual Meeting in June
6. Alternates will be selected in case the awardees fail to attend college or provide proper documentation
